



Force Select Soccer Club 07-08 Player Agreement



Congratulations on your selection for the Georgetown Soccer Association's Force Select Soccer Club! We welcome you and have confidence that you will be an outstanding representative of our association and club. Success in select soccer requires a commitment from the coaches, the players, and the parents. It is important that you understand what is expected and agree to meet the time, financial, and behavioral expectations of the club.

Each player is expected to:

- Attend all sessions (practices, games & Boot Camp) fully equipped (shin guards must be worn at all times and everyone should have their own ball and water) with an attitude toward learning and improving.
- Respect and support your team and teammates in action and word. Obscene language and/or actions which are disrespectful towards teammates, coaches, or other GSA participants will not be tolerated under any circumstance.
- Practice the skills taught at the training sessions outside of regular practice times.
- On game day, be on the field, in proper uniform, ready to play 45 minutes to one hour prior to the scheduled start time. The trainer will decide on the exact time.
- Adhere to the rules and regulations outlined in the *GSA Rules and Regulations Manual*, when applicable. Violation of these rules is subject to review by the D & P Committee.

Each parent is expected to:

- Have your player to the training sessions (practices & boot camp) and games on time and ready to participate.
- Positively cheer for all players on the team. Your support and confidence is important to the entire team.
- Control your emotions at games. Be a model of good sportsmanship for the players and parents from other teams. Show respect for the officials, coaches and the players at all times.
- Fulfill your financial obligations to the Georgetown Soccer Association. In addition to select fees, uniform cost and tournament/travel costs, these obligations include volunteering time for field preparation, tournaments, and other GSA functions and activities
- Pay select fees on time or communicate with GSA representatives regarding a need for payment extension or financial aid. Select fees are \$800 annually. Minimum payment requirements include 4 x \$200 payments due no later than the 15th of June, August, October & November (\$100 down payment required once contract is signed to be applied to June pmt.) Failure to make timely payments or make alternate arrangements with GSA can result in players being declared ineligible for practice/play.
- Adhere to the rules and regulations outlined in the *GSA Rules and Regulations Manual*, when applicable. Violation of these rules is subject to review by the D & P Committee.

GSA is expected to provide:

- A qualified trainer for the team to which the player is assigned. Trainers are paid for their services by GSA.
- Quality practice and game fields & equipment for the use of the team to which the player is assigned.
- 8 hours of preseason training to occur during the week of August 20th-23rd (Boot Camp)
- Team practice twice per week, with each session being no less then one and one half hours in length, beginning during August (Boot Camp) and ending in late May. Goalkeepers will have an additional 1 ½ hours weekly practice session during the months of August through November and February through May.
- Player registration fees payable to governing organization (CAYSA)
- Team registration fees for regular season league play and league play-off tournaments
- Internal infrastructure for managing programs such as registration, game/practice scheduling, fee payments, league/team communications, uniform acquisition, financial aid, discipline & protest, etc.
- A fun relaxed atmosphere conducive to developing soccer players and teams, while also developing individual self-esteem, character, social skills, community pride, and respect for one another.

There are costs associated with a select soccer program, including tournament fees and fundraisers. If you are unable to meet the financial commitments, please notify your Team Manager or the VP of Select to discuss opportunities for financial aid.
